In 1920, the artist Baladine Klossowska resumes her acquaintance with the poet Rainer Maria Rilke. Klossowska, a divorced mother of two teenage sons, one of whom will become the artist Balthus, falls passionately in love with Rilke, but after a brief *amour fou* Rilke begins to distance himself from her. While she abandons herself to her love for him and longs for unconditional intimacy and communion, he needs space and peace to write. They write each other yearning letters, constantly searching for the right balance of intimacy and distance. 'Merline', a feminine form of the French for blackbird, is Rilke's pet name for Klossowska. One of the letters to Merline will be the last he writes before he dies.

From 1920 until his death in 1929, Rilke had a passionate relationship with the Jewish artist Baladine, known to him affectionately as 'Merline'. Baladine is remembered as the mother of the artist Balthus, but has been forgotten as an artist in her own right.

Julia Franck, born in Berlin in 1970, is an award-winning author whose accolades include the *Schiller Memorial Prize*, the *Marie Luise Kaschnitz Prize* and the *German Book Prize*. Two of her novels, *LAGERFEUER (WEST)* and *DIE MITTAGSFRAU (THE BLIND SIDE OF THE HEART)*, have been made into films. Her books have been translated into forty languages. Women in the field of music are finally being heard!

How women create music and men reap the profits

Female singers like Beyoncé, Adele, or Taylor Swift might create the impression that “front women” are common in the music business across all genres. But for centuries, women were irrelevant, didn’t even play second fiddle (or any other instrument) in the music business. In many respects, this still holds true today. Take classical music: there is hardly any other profession where women find it as difficult to gain equal standing with men.

While female conductors like Joana Mallwitz attract media attention, they are rarely appreciated for their skills, but mainly for being women. Musicologist Cornelia Bartsch draws an arc from the Middle Ages to the present day, explains the mythological, political, and social underpinnings of women’s plight, and thereby provides an exemplary demonstration of how women have been oppressed for centuries and deprived of their voice.

Cornelia Bartsch numbers among the pioneers of gender studies in the field of musicology. Since completing her doctorate on Fanny Hensel at the Berlin University of the Arts, she has been carrying out research and teaching at music academies and universities in Germany, Austria, and Switzerland.
