




When will I finally know what I want?

Dirk Rossmann was born in 1946, and in 1972 he founded Germany's first self-service drugstore. Today the ROSSMANN Group has 4,100 branches in Germany and seven foreign subsidiaries. Dirk Rossmann is deeply committed to the fight against climate change. Josef Settele is a biologist at the Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research, an adjunct professor at the University of Halle-Wittenberg and, since 2020, a member of the German Advisory Council on the Environment. Josef Settele conducts research on nature conservation, the evolution of insects, and biodiversity in relation to land use, among other areas.

A new edition of Hans Rosenthal's moving life story to commemorate his 100th birthday in April 2025

Four decades after its first publication, and in view of the political shift to the right, this is a book of particularly high caliber

Hans Rosenthal, born in Berlin in 1925, was a director, moderator, and entertainer. After the end of the Second World War, he built a career at RIAS, a radio station founded by the Americans in West Berlin, creating dozens of successful quiz programs and entertaining shows between 1950 and 1980. At the same time, he became one of Germany's most popular TV entertainers. The shows he hosted, such as "Dalli Dalli" and "Gut gefragt, ist halb gewonnen," were enjoyed by millions. He was honored with a Goldene Kamera, a Bambi, and the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany, among other awards. Hans Rosenthal died in Berlin in 1987.

A moving contemporary document calling for greater tolerance and coexistence

"I actually led two lives."

Hans Rosenthal narrowly escaped death seven times – as he writes in his autobiography, which is now being published in a new edition to mark his 100th birthday. A popular TV presenter who entertained an audience of millions in the 1970s with shows like DALLI DALLI, Rosenthal barely survived the Holocaust. His book recounts the early death of his parents, his deportation and the murder of his younger brother, forced labor in fields, factories, and cemeteries, and the everpresent fear of being killed by the Nazis. Yet he also writes about three German women who put their own lives at risk to save his. And about a career that might well have been impossible without reconciliation.
