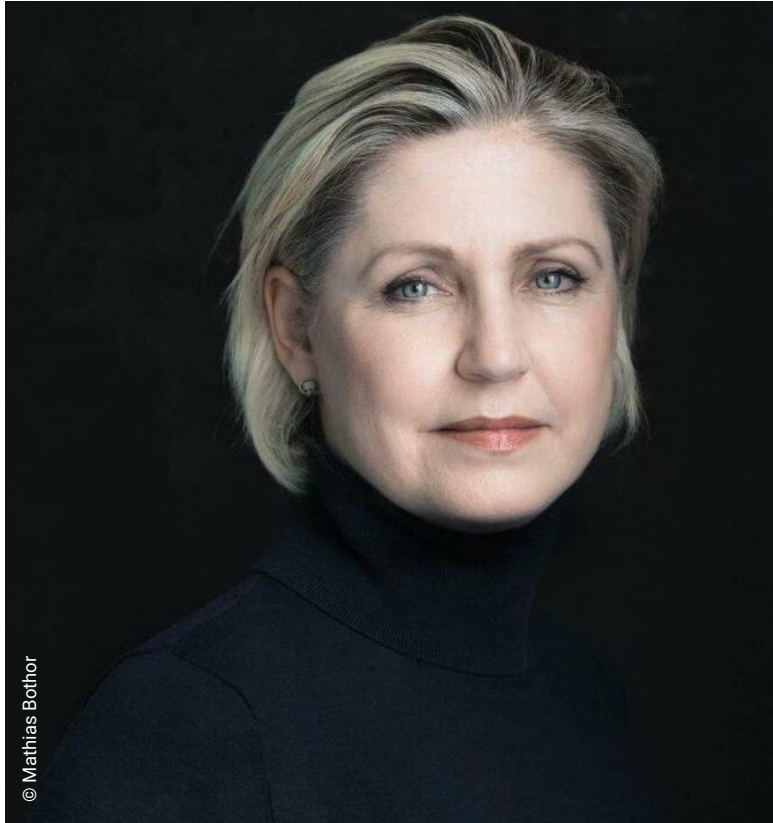

Florian Illies was born in 1971. He served as Arts and Ideas editor for *Frankfurter Allgemeine Sonntagszeitung*, managed the Villa Grisebach auction house, and is co-publisher of *DIE ZEIT*. Illies's international bestselling 1913: THE YEAR BEFORE THE STORM established a new genre. His most recent publications are the bestsellers THE MAGIC OF SILENCE: CASPAR DAVID FRIEDRICH'S JOURNEY THROUGH TIME and AS THE SUN GOES DOWN: THE MANN FAMILY IN SANARY.

Poland was off to a faster start. In 2005 and 2015, the country elected a right-wing populist government drawn from the Law and Justice Party (PiS), at a time when the AfD in Germany was still ramping up. A pioneering analysis of digital colonialism as a global phenomenon

Satyajeet Malik is studying political science at the Leuphana University in Lüneburg, with a focus on the microchip war between the USA and China. Based on his activity as a human rights lawyer in India, he was awarded a Helmut Schmidt scholarship sponsored by the German Academic Exchange Service. Additionally, he works as a freelance journalist who writes on topics related to digital colonialism and geopolitical developments in the Indo-Pacific region.

Colonialism is alive and well – with a new digital look, but the same brutality against populations and the natural environment.

The global digital ecosystem is controlled by a handful of technology corporations. It is founded on dependencies that developed during the classic colonial era. Today, however, colonizers no longer need to maintain a physical presence in a colonized country to lash out at its population. The global digital architecture provides colonial overlords with more subtle tools of exploitation.

In this groundbreaking book, Satyajeet Malik points out the structural and systemic developments of a global architecture whose objective is to undermine the sovereignty and intensify the exploitation of the Global South. Even if the forms and strategy of colonial exploitation have changed, the primary objective remains the same, namely, to extract wealth and resources at the expense of others.

Take Brazil as an example: unfair legislation ensures massive tax savings for Facebook, Google, and Microsoft in the Global South. Countries like Brazil lack the money required to finally strengthen their healthcare and education systems.

Take the **Congo**, where Apple and Tesla collaborate with companies that disregard children's rights and exploit the population. The brutal working conditions in cobalt mines repeatedly lead to fatal accidents. Even though the Congo owns 70% of this currently key raw material, people there live in abject poverty.

Take **Kenya**, where day in and day out poorly paid employees sift through hundreds of brutal videos depicting murders, rapes, or child abuse to keep them from the eyes of social media users in the West; psychologically traumatizing work performed for starvation wages.

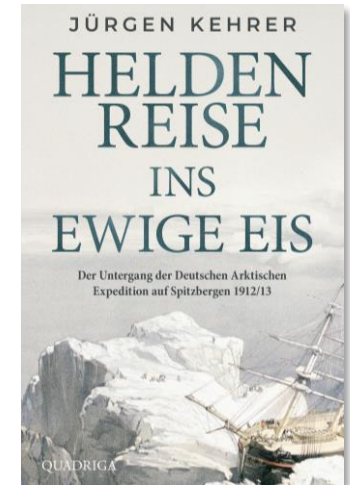

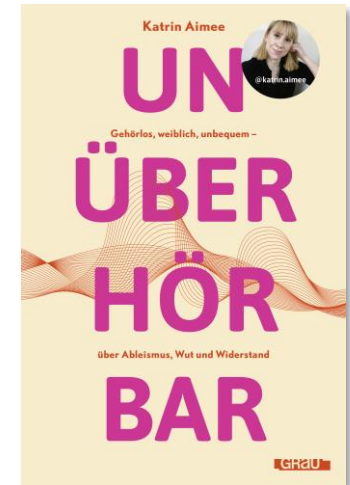

Don't be an inconvenience, don't stand out – for a long time these principles shaped Katrin Aimee's life. In her book she writes about the long and arduous process of getting a diagnosis of deafness, and the difficulties she faced within an education system that was not designed for her. She also describes the psychological wounds inflicted upon her by other people as a result of her disability.

When she was thirteen, for example, Katrin asked her teacher to wear a microphone so that Katrin, despite her severe hearing impairment, would still be able to understand her. She was met with a curt refusal. Katrin fell silent, ashamed. She had long since internalised the idea that, as a disabled woman, she was allowed to exist but only as long as she did not cause any inconvenience to anyone.

With great candour and analytical acuity, Katrin Aimee illustrates the impact of structural discrimination. Without complaint or self-pity, she calls for a society which accepts diversity as a matter of course and in which all human beings are entitled to their basic human rights.

Katrin Maag a.k.a. »Katrin Aimee« has personal experience of what it is like to be subjected to structural discrimination: she is deaf, and had to learn to fight for her rights even as a child. A trained psychologist, she has worked for several years in the field of diversity and inclusion in the education sector, and is a strong pro-feminist and anti-ableist voice on Instagram and TikTok. **BEING HEARD** is her first book.

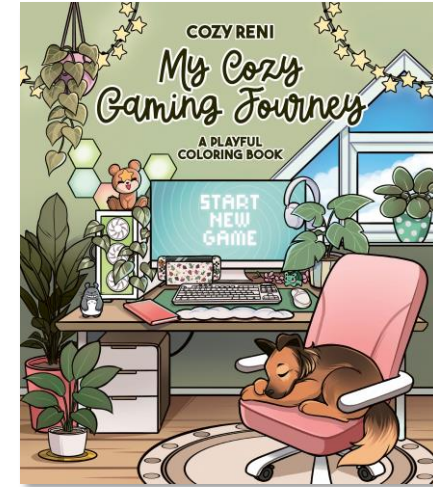

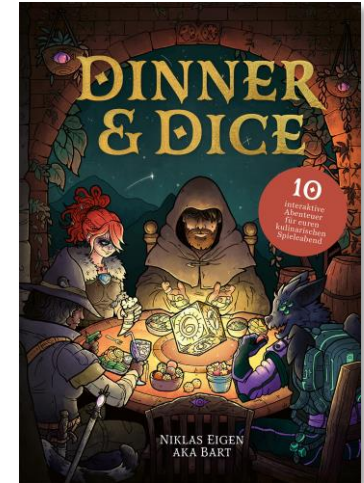
